Construction at Carshalton College

The course will run over 10 weeks and give participants an insight to some of the trades and skills within the construction industry.



During the programme, areas covered could include;

- Health and safety in construction trades
- Preparing to carry out carpentry and joinery
- Carpentry and joinery skills
- Clean and store carpentry and joinery tools and equipment
- Preparing to carry out bricklaying
- Brick laying skills
- Clear and store bricklaying tools and equipment
- Structure of the construction industry
- Fundamental safe working practices
- Environmental and sustainability measure in domestic dwellings
- Site preparation for working in the construction industry
- Electrical installation wiring and terminations
- Fabrication techniques for electrical installation
- Electrical science and technology

- Possible visit to nursery
- Looking at physical, intellectual, emotional and social development

Motor Vehicle at Carshalton College

The course will run over 10 weeks and give participants an insight to some of the trades and skills within the motor vehicle industry.

- Health and safety in motor vehicle trades
- Preparing to carry out motor vehicle task
- Workshop tools and equipment checking
- Maintaining car tyre pressure and tread
- Remove and replace motor vehicle road wheels
- Clean interior and exterior of vehicle
- Remove and replace spark plugs
- Making and producing a product within hand-skills workshop
- Metal cutting and filing
- Using various motor vehicle tools
