Sutton Music Service is the lead partner in the Sutton Music Education Hub and works to implement the aspirations of the National Plan for Music Education (2011).

We aim to help every young person in the London Borough of Sutton to make, be inspired by, and to celebrate the music they love. It is the job of the Sutton Music Hub to deliver this vision and coordinate all the people, partners, and resources needed to consistently strive to reach this aim. We value your feedback about our delivery model and use it to continuously improve our offer's quality. We are committed to providing outstanding learning and teaching, which is outlined in our teaching and learning policy.

Thank you to the schools in Sutton for your continued support, especially over the past 12 months. By working in partnership, we have been able to:

- Deliver First Access Whole Class Ensemble Tuition (WCET) curriculums to 2180 pupils in 21 different schools.
- Support nearly 1000 students on their musical journey through:
 - in-school peripatetic vocal and instrumental lessons
 - tuition at our Wednesday & Saturday Music Academy
 - our borough orchestras, bands, and choirs
 - our affordable instrument hire scheme
- Support children and young people across the borough by:
 - supporting the Sutton Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme
 - delivering Youth Music funded work for students with sensory impairments
 - supporting students with profound and multiple learning disabilities and severe learning disabilities through our Open Orchestra programme
 - our EYFS music offer
 - working with the Sutton Virtual School to ensure that children who are looked after do not miss out on the opportunity to make and learn music
 - collaborating with the Paving the Way team to support students with various difficulties, including social communication, attention and concentration, and anxiety

Our Whole Class Ensemble Tuition (WCET) curriculums make a genuine contribution to pupils' personal development, providing a rich experience and an opportunity to develop their talents and interests.

Sutton Music Service is committed to giving every child the opportunity to play a musical instrument as outlined in the National Plan for Music Education. We hope to engage with your school in 2022-23.

Our WCET curriculum has been enjoyed by nearly 2200 children in Sutton this academic year and is a fantastic way of supporting a broad and balanced curriculum in your school.

Each July, Sutton Music Service WCET curriculums culminate in the KS2 Festival at the world-famous Phoenix Concert Hall, Fairfield Halls in Croydon. This concert involves participants from all schools involved in the WCET performance curriculums and will also include fun workshops throughout the day from our Sutton Music Hub Partners.

Quality Assurance

To ensure that our WCET curriculum has the maximum impact on your pupils, our quality assurance measures include:

- WCET Curriculum Vision: Intent, Implementation and Impact
- WCET overview that maps well-sequenced musical outcomes, knowledge and skills
- National Curriculum links
- Weekly schemes of work
- Embedded Sutton Singing Strategy
- Two formal tutor observations per year
- Tutors make audio recordings of their classes work each half term as evidence of progress
- End of year assessment and report statements
- Specialist instrumental tutors who have taken part in Cognus Limited Safeguarding training and Sutton Music Service Teaching & Learning CPD

School-based Ensembles

Peripatetic lessons

Sutton Music Service offers vocal and instrumental tuition to pupils in Sutton schools, during their school day. We offer tuition on a range of instruments, including:

- Vocals
- Guitar
- Bass Guitar
- Drum Kit
- Piano
- Woodwind (flute, clarinet or saxophone)
- Strings (violin, viola or cello)
- Brass (trumpet or trombone)

All our tutors are specialists and talented musicians. They are well qualified, have followed Cognus Limited's safer recruitment procedures, and have an Enhanced DBS.

How it works!

- When a school asks Sutton Music Service to provide peripatetic lessons, we provide the Music Coordinator with a letter to send to parents and information for the school website.
- Parents enroll for lessons via our website.
- Sutton Music Service bills the parents directly.
- We centrally track pupil attendance and progress.
- The tutors have regular lesson observations and receive ongoing guidance to help develop their teaching and learning.
