# OTHER TEAM MEMBERS:



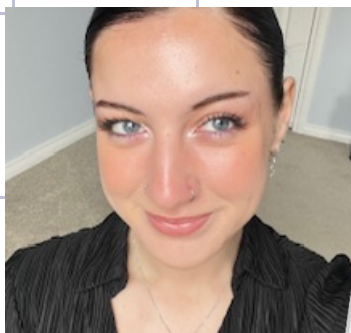

# OTHER TEAM MEMBERS:

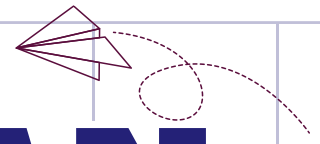

- We might invite you to special events or activities to help with your learning!

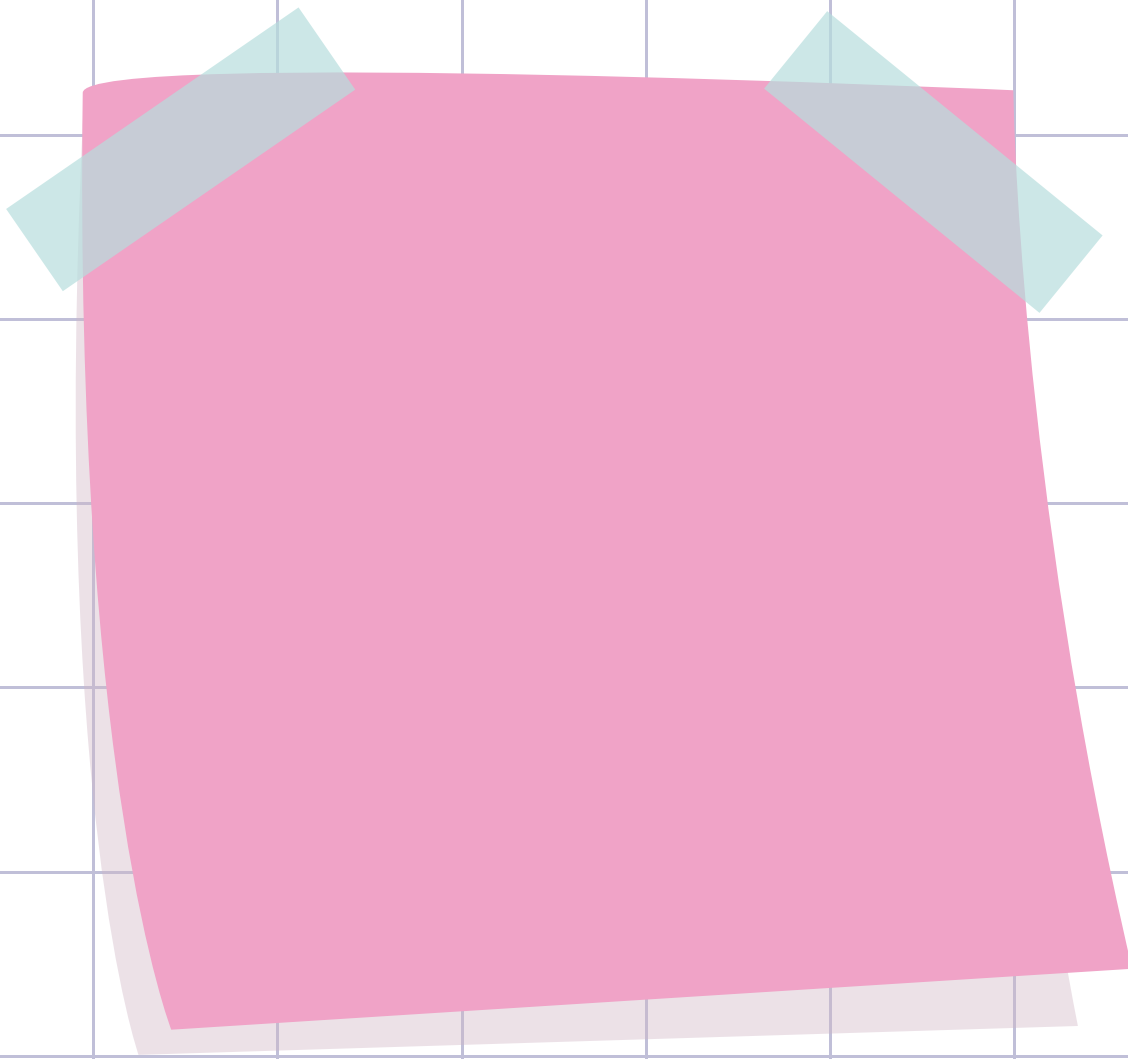
