Introducing 'The Framework for Thinking' - A tool for schools to support students with acquired brain injury.

The ABI Framework Guidance is a practical and research-informed resource aimed at helping educators support children and young people returning to school after an Acquired Brain Injury (ABI). It outlines the wideranging and often hidden effects of ABI -such as cognitive, emotional, and social challenges—and stresses the importance of understanding each child's unique experience. Central to the guidance is the "Framework for Thinking," a reflective tool designed to help schools create inclusive environments that promote a sense of belonging and emotional wellbeing. The document encourages collaboration with families and professionals, and highlights the value of listening to the child's voice in shaping support.
