👉 This year, we have enjoyed delivering both individual and group interventions each week, supporting students with a range of needs who may benefit from additional support within the school environment. Through regular supervision with our Educational Psychologist, intervention plans are discussed and implemented following parental input, allowing us to work directly with students while also supporting them systemically through collaboration with home and school. Alongside this, we contribute to parent and school consultations, support staff through training on topics such as Executive Functioning and Emotionally-Based School Avoidance, and assist with the delivery of a Year 7 and 8 Nurture Group twice a week - including one session involving a particularly chaotic cooking activity!

As APs, we also assist, observe, and learn from the Educational Psychologists at Cognus, making this an incredibly rewarding role with continual opportunities for professional growth. 🗨️
